Huge thanks to everyone for the continued efforts to help our school to run the new systems smoothly, so that we can be open to all pupils. Attendance is high but understandably, some children are needing to be absent whilst Covid-19 tests are taken. Unfortunately, this process is proving lengthy and pupils, plus family members, must isolate until a Covid-19 negative test result is achieved.

We are going to be opening another gate at the end of the day, (Monday to Thursday) to alleviate any congestion at the front of the school. This gate is often referred to as 'ginnel' because it is the local name for an alleyway. As the ginnel is so narrow, it must only be used as a way out and never a way in.

COVID ADVICE

A joint message from Church Stretton Medical Practice and St Lawrence Primary School

We understand it can be difficult to know what to do if your child has new symptoms. We hope this short guide will assist you.

The main symptoms of COVID are

a high temperature - feels hot to touch on back or chest / measured over 37.8C

a new continuous cough - more than 1 hour at a time, or 3 or more episodes of coughing in 24hrs

a loss of or change in sense of smell or taste

If your child has one or more of these symptoms please arrange a COVID test and follow self-isolating guidelines.

You can book a test on nhs.uk/coronavirus, or if you do not have internet access, call 119.

Please continue to self-isolate until results are available.

Your child can return to school if

- the test was NEGATIVE *and* your child is well enough
- the test was POSITIVE *and* more than 10 days have passed since the start of their symptoms, *and* they are well enough

If they remain unwell after 10 days and had a positive test they should remain off school until recovered.

There is *no need* to call your GP to

- tell us you are self-isolating
- you have requested a test

GPs cannot order a test on your behalf.

If you are concerned about your child's health (COVID or other) then please contact your GP or 111 as normal. If you have queries about COVID symptoms you can call 111 at any time.

Other COVID symptoms in children.

It has been reported that children can have other symptoms related to COVID. This can include all the common childhood symptoms such as sore throat, runny nose, headaches, aches and pains, stomach upset and tiredness

If you are concerned about your child's health because they are significantly unwell you should contact your GP / 111 as normal.

At this time the government advice is that these symptoms do NOT warrant COVID testing or self-isolation. However if you are unsure please call 111.
