Headteacher's Spotlight

Although new coronavirus measures have been brought in across the country, school arrangements remain the same. However, with cases rising and the virus spreading we do need to ensure that we are doing all that we can to keep the risk of infection on the school site as low as possible. In particular parents can help us by:-


- * Continuing to keep pupils away from school when they display coronavirus symptoms and arranging tests asap.
- * Ensuring all members of the household isolate whilst the result of a test is being awaited.
- * Sending us a copy of the email that outlines the outcome of a Coronavirus test as soon as it is received.
- * Keeping 2 metres apart from each other and members of staff when on the school site and follow the one way system (unless instructed otherwise by duty staff).
- * Trying not to return to school to drop water bottles and coats off. Ensure children have them with them at drop-off.
- * Walking or cycling to school if you live close (ie Church Stretton/All Stretton) rather than bringing the car. The leisure centre car park is getting increasingly busy, and walking/cycling will help to relieve congestion.
- * Ensuring that children arrive before 9:00am in the morning and collected by 3:15pm (by 1:15pm on a Friday).
- * Continuing to take as much care as possible not to put children at risk of catching the virus when not at school. Remember, if one pupil tests positive the likelihood is that two/three classes of pupils would need to isolate at home for two weeks.
- * Only visiting the school office when this is essential and wear a mask when doing so.

Parents' evening will take the form of phone calls with parents from teachers throughout October. Information on how to book a phone call will be shared soon.
