Tuesday 1st December 2020

All school children in Reception, Y1, Y2, Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6 born between 01/09/2009 and 31/08/2016 will be offered the flu vaccine.

The children have today been given the consent form for the flu vaccination (nasal spray). This will take place in school on Tuesday 1st December.

If you would like your child to receive the immunisation in school, please complete the form and return it to the school office by Monday 23rd November 2020.

If you decide you do not want to vaccinate your child against flu, please return the form indicating No consent. This will help the NHS plan and improve the service.

**Please note, if we do not receive a signed consent form from you by this date, your child will not be given the immunisation in school.**
