- To enhance their determination and confidence.


#### Expressive Arts and Design


- To identify different materials.

## Enquiry-based learning

## Understanding the World

- To explain what a vehicle is.
- To compare and discuss vehicles from the past and present.
- To explore and identify a range of vehicles.
- To use directional language.

#### **Mathematics**

- To interpret data regarding how the children travel to school.
- To explore mass and capacity.
- To use length, height and time in real-life contexts.
- To name, identify properties and sort 3D shapes.

#### Literacy

- To draw key information from a story and sequence main events.
- To identify and talk about basic features of a book (characters, plot, etc.) and discuss non-fiction and fiction through experience of the local library.
- To use Phase 2-3 Phonic knowledge to write labels and captions.

Termly plans provide starting points for learning and link to an overall theme. The open-ended questions, visits and interviews stimulate children's lines of enquiry, conversations and interests which can then be used to focus learning each week.
